Advocate to the federal and provincial governments to increase police resources in the County.

Rationale for this proposed High Priority Strategy

This strategy focuses on the areas of enforcement that that county has authority and jurisdiction over while advocating for more RCMP and provincial Sheriff resources to address rural crime to the federal and provincial governments.

Create an engaged community (Goal 3.1)	Increase regular communication to residents on county initiatives, services, projects and programs.	Increase communication to residents through a monthly County Chronicle.

This strategy focuses on increasing regular communication to residents about the work the county is doing to address residents' needs and concerns. The strategy also increases opportunities and methods of interaction to help keep residents informed and engaged.
