

Albert & Maria Rimer Memorial Scholarship

About the Scholarship

In memory of his parents (Mr. and Mrs. Albert Rimer), Mr. Bert Rimer has provided Leduc County the sum of \$50,000 for a scholarship for a student who attains his or her high school diploma from Warburg High School and continues further education, through an accredited College or University, in the field of Agriculture and/or Agricultural/Food. Secondary consideration will be provided to those students entering the field of Health Sciences (medical field). The Scholarship is to be known as the "Albert & Maria Rimer Memorial Scholarship."

Amount to be Awarded

The amount of the scholarship shall be determined by the interest accumulated on the investment during the preceding year. This amount may vary from year to year depending on the interest rate at which the donation had been invested; however, the scholarship provided will not be less than \$1,000 in any given year. Only one award will be made in any one year.

Eligibility

To be eligible, the student must:

- have graduated from Warburg High School
- have declared a major in the field of Agriculture and/or Agricultural/Food
- secondary consideration will be provided students who have declared a major in the field of Health Sciences (medical field)
- financial need will be considered in the awarding of the scholarship
- must not have previously received this scholarship

Application Procedure

The applicant must submit a personal letter to Leduc County and include personal details, a Grade 12 transcript, proof of registration in a post-secondary program, and any other information the applicant believes is relevant.

Selection Process

Applicants shall be shortlisted by Council or a committee thereof with the final selection to be done by the same.

Reception of the Scholarship

The successful applicant will be invited to attend a Regular Council meeting to receive a cheque in the amount awarded.

It would be desirable for a member of the Rimer family to be invited to make the presentation. If not available, then presentation to be made by a member of Council.

Criteria for Review

If circumstances change so that the award cannot be offered in accordance with the original terms and conditions, Council may alter the terms and conditions of this scholarship.
